1. All participants may enter one (1) manuscript in each of the four (4) literary categories: Fiction, Nonfiction, Poetry – Free Verse, and Poetry – Rhyming.
2. All entries must be in English, typewritten and single-sided.
3. Entries must not violate the rights of any third party.
4. Each entry MUST have a cover page (information only, not to be published) including author's name, birthdate, address, phone, title of work, and category entered.
5. Each entry should have the title of the work centered on the top line of the manuscript. The author's name should be centered and double-spaced under the title.
6. All entries should have a minimum of one (1) inch margins.
7. Each poetry entry is limited to one single-sided, single-spaced entry no longer than twenty (20) lines.
8. Fiction and non-fiction participants are limited to one entry in each category of up to 1000 words. In no case shall any entry be longer than four (4) typewritten, single-sided, double-spaced pages.
9. The PAGE NUMBER, TITLE of work and CATEGORY entered shall be placed on all pages after page 1, TOP LEFT HAND CORNER of the manuscript.
10. Winners will be announced and medals presented at 7PM, June 18, 2008 at the Reception held at Quad City Arts Center, 1715 2nd Avenue, Rock Island IL 61201
11. Literary Arts will be compiled into a booklet. Each participant will receive one (1) at the Arts Reception. Additional books will be available for \$10 each at the Quad City Arts Center throughout the display and at QCSO Headquarters, PepsiCo Rec Center, 1025 30th Street on the Augustana campus during the games.
